THE TITLEIST APPROACH

- Titleist Performance Golf Ball Fitting focuses on lowering your score
- The best place to determine the best golf ball for your game is on the golf course
- Golf ball fitting is best conducted from green-to-tee considering all of your shots
- All Titleist golf balls are long
- Most scoring opportunities are created by shots to the green

GETTING STARTED

- Use a Titleist Golf Ball Selection Tool to find the two Titleist golf ball models best suited for your game
- Take the two golf balls to the golf course for the on course evaluation process - be sure to execute all shots using both models
- Use the chart to the right to track which golf ball performs best for each type of shot

KEY CONSIDERATIONS WHEN COMPARING:

- Score
- Proximity to the pin
- Greens hit
- Fairways hit
- Feel preference

GOLF BALL EVALUATION & SCORING

Now that you've narrowed your selection to two Titleist golf balls, write them in the space provided and use the following steps to determine which ball is best for your game.

RECOMMENDED BALL

ALTERNATIVE BALL

(SELECT YOUR PREFERENCE BELOW)

COMPARE

Begin with several different **SHORT GAME** shots.

Hit **FULL SWING** shots with a short iron.

Next hit **FULL SWING** on longer shots.

Continue full shots with **HYBRIDS/FAIRWAY METALS**.

Finally hit tee shots with your **DRIVER**.
